Squibs and Discussions: report for 2005

At the beginning of year 2005, there were four submissions in the squibs pipeline. In the course of year 2005, 14 additional papers were (re-) submitted. At the end of the year, there was only one submissions left in the pipeline. Thus, 17 decisions were made during year 2005. The results were as follows:

- * 5 papers accepted
- * 4 papers rejected
- * 8 invitations to rework the (re-)submission

The mean time taken for these decisions was 115 days.

Thus far, 9 papers have been (re-) submitted in 2005.
